

Thanksgiving and Holiday Travel

In light of the upcoming holidays, we at Great Lakes/DCM wanted to take a minute to remind our staff of the recent PA Order from the Department of Health relating to travel and would like you to consider this information prior to returning to work from any out of state travel.

Effective Friday, November 20th, the Secretary of Health issued an order that Pennsylvanians visiting other states are required to have **a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to their return** to the commonwealth, or to **quarantine for 14 days** upon return to Pennsylvania.
